Applicant/Owner: Epic Wireless Group/ Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District (SRCSD)

Location: A property located at 1000 River Walk Way, southeast of the River Walk Way access to

the Jedediah Smith Memorial Trail in the American River Parkway in the Carmichael/Old

Foothill Farms community.

Request: 1. A **Use Permit** from the Planning Commission for the following:

a. Allow a new cell tower in a Group 1 zoning district.

b. Allow identification signage to exceed 24 square feet in area.

2. A **Special Development Permit** from the Planning Commission for the following:

a. Deviate from the 55 feet height maximum for cell towers located in Group 1 zoning to allow the proposed cell tower to be 61 feet in height.

b. Deviate from separation distance minimums to allow the proposed cell tower

to be located adjacent to Group 1 zoning.

c. Deviate from screened fencing standards to allow the proposed chain-link

fencing without slats.

3. A **Design Review** to comply with the Countywide Design Guidelines.
