The Haven would be a permanent habitat for a maximum of 75 Squirrel Monkeys retired from research. The Haven would consist of both outdoor and indoor housing as follows: (1) An existing horse barn would be converted to indoor housing for the monkeys. Box-stalls would be removed and replaced with custom designed and constructed caging appropriate to house the monkeys; and (2) Outdoor habitats would be constructed with appropriate caging and filled with plantings. The outdoor habitats would be connected to the indoor housing by caged runways.
