## Information Necessary on Preliminary Landscape Plans Submitted for Design Review:

- Drawing to be on a title block with designer contact info, north arrow, scale including bar scale. Drawings shall be at a common scale to fit on one sheet preferably no less than 1" = 20'.
- 2. Design statement and concept (demonstration of knowledge of water conservation goals, development standards, and design guidelines).
- 3. A planting layout showing tree symbols at ¾ mature sizes (not to exceed 30′-35′ diameter), shrubs and groundcover areas including proposed lawn (by hatch symbol), water features, and storm water quality features. Storm water quality features may require cross sections.
- 4. A candidate plant list or legend of proposed trees and shrubs, including common and botanical name, and water use designation per the WUCOLS IV document.
- 5. A table or callouts indicating species of all existing trees.
- 6. A preliminary shade calculation in the County's format demonstrating compliance with County requirements.
- 7. The square footage of landscape area proposed.
- 8. Dimensions on all required planter widths (all required widths exclude curbs).
- 9. Preliminary landscape grades, or indications of slopes.
- 10. Site boundaries including property lines, right of way, and setbacks.
- 11. Existing and proposed buildings, streets with street names, parking areas, walkways, fences and walls (include approximate height), trash enclosures, light fixtures, utility boxes, transformers, fire equipment, monument signs etc.
- 12. Indication of surface types (turf, decomposed granite, concrete, asphalt, pervious pavers etc.).
